



## Lakes District (4 days / 3 nights)

Located within a mere two-hour flight from Santiago, the enchanting city of Puerto Varas captivates and delights travelers with its rich cultural tapestry. At every turn, the city's architecture and culinary offerings reminders of its illustrious history, tracing back to the arrival of German settlers two centuries ago. These pioneers transformed the landscape from dense river jungles to thriving agricultural lands. Furthermore, Puerto Varas boasts an abundance of natural wonders, generously offering dreamlike landscapes comprising lakes, volcanoes, islands, and pristine native forests. A three-night stay in this captivating locale beckons visitors to return at any time of the year.

### Itinerary:

Day 01: After your arrival in the morning at the Puerto Montt airport, reception and transfer by private service to your hotel.

Day 02: In the morning we will begin our excursion, visiting the city of Llanquihue, famous for its cured meat, then we will border Lake Llanquihue to head towards Frutillar. We arrived at this city which is a beautiful town reminiscent of Bavaria, where its first settlers came from. It emerged in 1856 as a shipping dock, with tanneries, mills, breweries, etc. soon appearing. We will walk around its beautiful old German-style houses, admiring its well-kept gardens and its incomparable view of the Osorno and Puntagudo volcanoes. Included visit to the German Colonial Museum that shows the life of the settlers and free time to enjoy a coffee with a typical German pastry from this area. On its Costanera we will observe the Teatro del Lago where the famous "Frutillar Musical Weeks" are held annually with worldwide attendance. Return to the hotel at noon and free afternoon.

Day 03: In the morning departure for a full-day excursion to discover the perfect trilogy in Vicente Perez Rosales National Park: the adventure of the Osorno Volcano, the beauty of the Petrohué Falls and the turquoise color of Lake Todos los Santos. We will begin our excursion bordering Lake Llanquihue and enjoy a beautiful postcard with the snow-capped Osorno and Calbuco volcanoes in the background, until we reach the Ensenada sector and then take the ascent route until we reach the SKI Center and Osorno Volcano Mountain, located at 1,240 meters of altitude. We will be there for about an hour where there will be time to enjoy the landscape, take photographs, and appreciate an unparalleled view of the summit of the volcanoes (Calbuco and Osorno), Lake Llanquihue and the Pacific Ocean. Then we will begin the descent towards the Ensenada sector and arrive at Los Saltos de Petrohue to see one of the most iconic sites in the sector, the "Saltos del Petrohué" viewpoint, a place where the river appears between large masses of crystallized lava. . This tour lasts around 30 minutes. Lunch included in the Ensenada sector and return to your hotel in the afternoon.

Day 04: After breakfast private transfer back to Puerto Montt Airport.
